

A unique location, sweeping plains set against the breathtaking backdrop of the snow-capped Andes, Mendoza has over 400 years of winemaking history. Mendoza is a mecca of winemaking. Home of the legendary French grape Malbec, the region produces red wines of great concentration and intensity.







The largest wine region in Argentina, Mendoza is located on a high-altitude plateau at the foot of the Andes Mountains. The province is responsible for roughly 70 percent of the country's annual wine production and is one of the main producing centres in the world.



The geography of the Andes in this region generates a unique micro-climate which is ideal for the cultivation of vines. Mendoza is divided into five large sub-regions: Valle de Uco; Primera Zona; Northern oasis; the East and the South.



The soils in Mendoza are Andean in origin and have been deposited over thousands of years by the region's rivers. These rocky, sandy soils have little organic matter and are free-draining, making them dry and low in fertility. This kind of soil is perfect for viticulture – vines are forced to work hard for hydration and nutrients, and will produce small, concentrated berries in lieu of leafy foliage.



The wines produced from grapes grown on these soils are often highly structured, with firm tannins, and have a distinct minerality that is often attributed to the soil.



Main grape varieties: Malbec.

Chardonnay, Cabernet Sauvignon, Pinot Noir & Cabernet Franc are also very important grapes in the GI based on the quality of the wines made from these varietals



# **SuperUco Vineyard**

Los Chacayes, Uco Valley. Mendoza, Argentina.

Owned by Michielini Brothers and Daniel Sanmartino, the winery is situated at the foot of the Andes Mountains in the heart of the Uco Valley, one of the main viniculture regions in Argentina. The land comprises 2 hectares (4,94 acres) in 3 different terroirs: Gualtallary, Altamira and Los Chachayes. The three form the perfect brotherhood between 1,200 and 1,450 meters above sea level.





#### **About the winemaker**

SuperUco produces organic and biodynamic wines. Their philosophy is to express the terroir so in order to do that, they don't use pesticides in their vines nor use chemicals during the harvest. Also, they don't overripe the grapes,

do not use sulphites, nor filtre their wines.

Then they ferment with natural yeasts in noble materials such as concrete, wood and foudre. Later, the wine rested in a combination of new and 2nd use French Oak for 16 to 20 months.



# Monteviejo Vineyard

Clodomiro Silva, Vista Flores, Mendoza, Argentina.

Owned by François Boursaud (Chateau Le Gay, Pomerol, France), the winery is situated at the foot of the Andes Mountains in the heart of the Uco Valley, one of the main viniculture regions in Argentina. The property comprises 130 hectares (321 acres) at an altitude between 1,000 and 1,200 meters above sea level.

The land slopes towards the north and east, giving it the best exposure to sunlight in the southern hemisphere.





#### About the winemaker

Marcelo Pelleriti is a global reference in the enology industry with extensive experience in Argentina and France. He was the first Latin-American winemaker to obtain 100 Robert Parker points for a French wine. He has also received high scores on his Argentinian wines. Trained by master winemaker Michel Rolland Marcelo has forged his own path, creating wines that are recognised worldwide.

# Kalós Wines Vineyard

Uco Valley, Mendoza, Argentina.

The Losada family decided to produce wines of the highest quality to pay tribute to the wine of the region and thank local people for their hospitality.

"Kalós" in Greek means "something of great beauty". So, they selected the best grapes in Altamira and brought together winemakers Pablo Benavides and Fabián Valenzuela to make their wines.

Not having a winery of their own, Kalós Wines is a project that honours Calixto, the Losada family's grandfather, and the names of the wines have been inspired by stories from his life.





#### **About the winemaker**

Pablo Benavides is a young winemaker from Mendoza who has an energetic spirit. He holds a technical degree in enology and horticulture from Don Bosco School. His mission in every project is to go beyond the boundaries of traditional winemaking, leaving the imprint of his own personal style in each new creation.

At Kalós Wines he found a balance that reflects his creations. He focuses on every production stage with equal emphasis, in order to craft boutique wines of a unique quality.



# **Domiciano Vineyard**

Maipú, Mendoza, Argentina.

Domiciano de Barrancas is a family winery, loving and respectful of good wine. The vineyards of Domiciano de Barrancas are located in the heart of Barrancas, south of the Mendoza River. The climate is dry and sunny, with great diurnal range; this allows a slow and progressive maturation, harmonising the sugar-acidity ratio. The tall trellises are irrigated with the purest water, the melting snow of the Andes.





# About their winemaking

Domiciano produces wines with 100% Malbec grapes, harvested during the fresh nights in our farms in Barrancas to avoid oxidation and thus preserve the maximum aromatic expression. Once the grapes are taken into the cellar, they are allowed to macerate at cold, controlled temperatures for 5 days in stainless-steel tanks.

Then they ferment with selected yeasts, maintaining the temperature between 25 to 28°C for approximately 15 days. Later, the wine rested in a combination of French and American oak for 10 months.



# **Cinco Sentidos Vineyard**

Rivadavia, Mendoza, Argentina.

Since 1955, Cinco Sentidos have followed Mendoza's noble tradition of high-quality winemaking. Today, this path of history finds them enjoying what they love best and know most about: making wines that can evoke thousands of moments and transmit numerous life experiences. Their vineyards cover 100 hectares located in the Uco Valley, Mendoza a most privileged location at an altitude of 850m. The vineyards sit at the banks of the Mendoza River, bringing out a silty loam alluvial soil of deep character, in a dry region with little rainfall and clearly marked seasons.





#### **About the winemaker**

Rodrigo Gasparoni is an up-and-coming, award-winning young oenologist from Argentina who has been locally and internationally recognised for his creations. He has an innovative and fresh approach to winemaking, that has positioned him as one of Argentina's top oenologists Under 40."



# **Bodega Santa Julia**

De Familia Zuccardi

Maipú, Mendoza, Argentina.

Bodega Santa Julia is a family company founded in 1963 by Engineer Alberto Zuccardi. He began planting vines in Maipú (province of Mendoza), experimenting with an irrigation system of his own creation based on a method used in California. Fifty years after the starting on this path, Zuccardi's legacy is well established, three generations joined by a passion for wine.





### **About the winemaker**

Rubén Ruffo graduated from the college of Don Bosco at the University of Juan Agustín Maza, in Mendoza in 1990, with a degree in Oenology. Since then, he has overseen more than 25 harvests at the winery.

Motivated to develop his technical expertise and acquiring experience in a VARIETAL of winemaking techniques, he has travelled extensively, working harvests in France, Rioja, Ribera del Duero and Cataluña, Spain and Verona, Italia. An enthusiastic winemaker, Rubén shows his excellence in attention to detail and his passion for what he makes.






Salta is one of the worlds highest altitude wine regions. With 2,600 hectares of vines growing between 1,700 and 3,200 meters above sea level, it is also one of the worlds most exclusive.

Cafayate is the winemaking heart of fine wines of this region.






Located 1,616 km north-west of the City of Buenos Aires, and 1,200 km north of Mendoza, is the Province of Salta. Covering a vast area, Salta displays a diverse array of landscapes: arid desert on the West, exuberant green rainforest on the East, valleys and gullies in the centre of the Province. These geographic conditions come together in Salta's small wine producing regions to create exceptional vine growing opportunities.

Cafayate is the most important valley in Salta and the main wine producer of the region. It is home to 60% of all the vines in the Calchagui Valley.

The high altitudes and the strength of the sun forced the grapes to adapt and thicken their skin. This characteristic of the grapes then translates into deeper-coloured wines with higher concentration of tannins.

This region is known for its creole grape Torrontes, a white grape, a fresh and fruity wine, aromatic with a distinctly floral and refreshing acidity.

Main varieties of grapes are Malbec, Torrontes (white), Cabernet Sauvignon, Tannat and Merlot.





# San Pedro de Yacochuya Vineyard

Cafayate, Salta, Argentina.

San Pedro de Yacochuya is Argentina's famous "treasure" of the domestic wine industry. The vineyard occupies a privileged nook in one of the world's highest wine-growing regions. It is the gold cradle of two of the sublime red wines in the country: the San Pedro de Yacochuya Tinto with a touch of cabernet sauvignon, and the premium 'Yacochuya', plain, without adjectives but with the very signature of Michel Rolland. Located at 2,035 meters above sea level with limited rainfall the terroir is something unique and matchless.





#### **About the winemaker**

Etchart is one of the surnames that is etched in the history of the modern wine industry in Argentina. Arnaldo Etchart was an Argentinian wine pioneer, leading the re-birth of the national wine with his vineyard in Cafayate. Now his children, third generation of vineyard owners, continue his legacy of wine making and innovation in San Pedro de Yacochuya - their premium boutique vineyard - and around the northern wine region. Marcos Etchart is the vineyards winemaker and together with Michel Rolland they develop their wines year upon year.

### **YACOCHUYA**

In 1988, Dany and Michel Rolland were asked to be consultants to one of the oldest families in the valley of Calchaquie. There they discovered Cafayate, a true paradise for viticulture in the north-west of Argentina. They fell in love with the country, its culture, traditions and its people. It was a 'coup de coeur'!

These French wine consultants were convinced that unique, outstanding wines could be produced in this mountain region of the Andes foothills.

This extremely beautiful region is situated several hundred kilometres to the south of the Tropic of Capricorn, at an altitude of 2,035m and has a very distinctive climate with hot days and cool nights.

Seduced, they decided to put all their passion and savoir-faire to work along their Argentinean friends to produce the wine called "Yacochuya".





# Domingo Molina Vineyard

Cafayate, Salta, Argentina.

The Domingo Molina winery is located in the province of Salta, 8 km west of Cafayate, in North Yacochuya. It lies on the Andean mountainside, overlooking the Calchaquí Valleys. Ranging from 1,600 to 2,300 meters above sea level, the vineyards enjoy a special microclimate with more than 300 days of sun, scarce rainfall, and a wide temperature range, all of which allow for excellent grape growing conditions. With vines over 100 years old, the Dominga Molina estate spreads over 60 hectares of deserticalluvial soil.

With no available electricity, Domingo Molina are the only ones to farm in this location, using gravity fed systems to water the vines. Hand-harvested and carefully selected before the destemming and crushing processes, each lot is vinified separately, with different winemaking processes using sustainable farming and cellaring practices.
